



120 PROPHETIC DECLARATIONS AND PRAYERPOINTS FOR 2026

Preface to the Prophetic Declarations and Prayerpoints

I pray that as you recite the following declarations of faith, the Almighty God will draw you closer to Himself and you will always experience God's tangible presence. Remember that there is nothing in this life that can be traded for God's awesome presence. As you look up to God the Father, I am confident in Christ that He will elevate you spiritually, socially, financially, vocationally, and professionally.

Key points to note about the prophetic declarations and the prayer points:

- Confessing prophetic declarations and prayerpoints is not a substitute for maintaining a living and meaningful relationship with God.
- Making declarations is not a substitute for an effective and heartfelt prayer life. Prayer requires a lot of preparation both physically and psychologically. Making declarations can never substitute adequate preparation to engage God Almighty in meaningful prayer.
- A confession of prayer points and declarations is not a substitute for regular Bible study. The word of God is supposed to anchor the daily life of any born-again Christian (Psalm 119: 11, 89, 105 and 130; Matthew 4: 3-10; Matthew 7: 24-29; Matthew 24: 35; John 8: 31-32; John 14: 21-26, and John 15: 1-8).

It is important that you ask God the Father to favor you with the presence of His Spirit before you start reciting the following prayer points. There is great power which is released when whatever we do or confess is inspired by the Spirit of God (John 14: 26 and Romans 8: 1-14). Our confessions and declarations before God's throne must not be made like the incantations that are recited by pagans before their fake gods.

Prophetic declarations must be made by faith with a strong sense of God-consciousness. At the end of the day, it is the Almighty God who is expected to bring everything we declare to pass. Our God is a relational God who listens to and responds to our prayers, cries, declarations and petitions as long as they are made in faith.

I. DIVINE MIRACLES (1–20)

1. I declare with settled faith that with God nothing before me is impossible, no matter how complex or delayed it appears. *Scripture*: “With God nothing will be impossible.” (Luke 1: 37)
2. I declare that my breakthrough will not come by human strength or strategy, but by the active work of God’s Spirit. *Scripture*: “Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit.” (Zechariah 4: 6)
3. I declare that the Lord is still at work in my life, performing wonders beyond my calculation and expectation. *Scripture*: “The LORD does wonders without number.” (Job 5: 9)
4. I declare that every question mark before me is answered by the limitless ability of the Lord. *Scripture*: “Is anything too hard for the LORD?” (Genesis 18: 14)
5. I declare that as I believe God, possibilities open where resistance once stood. *Scripture*: “All things are possible to him who believes.” (Mark 9: 23)
6. I declare that what unfolds in my life will be clearly traced to the hand of the Lord and not to chance. *Scripture*: “The hand of the LORD has done this.” (Job 12: 9)
7. I declare that sudden divine intervention can shake entrenched systems and bring immediate release. *Scripture*: “Suddenly there was a great earthquake.” (Acts 16: 26)
8. I declare that God is carefully completing every matter that concerns my destiny, nothing left unfinished. *Scripture*: “The LORD will perfect that which concerns me.” (Psalm 138: 8)
9. I declare that God creates a way where none is visible, even through impossible terrain. *Scripture*: “He makes a way in the sea.” (Isaiah 43: 16)
10. I declare that my life will ultimately reveal the glory of the Lord, not confusion or defeat. *Scripture*: “The glory of the LORD shall be revealed.” (Isaiah 40: 5)
11. I declare that divine intervention rises above natural limitations, biological barriers, and human constraints. *Scripture*: (Genesis 21)
12. I declare that God actively confirms His spoken word with tangible, supernatural results. *Scripture*: (Mark 16: 20)
13. I declare that prolonged delays do not cancel God’s promise but submit to His appointed time. *Scripture*: (Habakkuk 2: 3)
14. I declare that doors no human authority can shut are opening by God’s sovereign command. *Scripture*: (Revelation 3: 7)
15. I declare that divine reversals can overturn unfavourable narratives and establish God’s purpose. *Scripture*: (Esther 9: 1)
16. I declare that every barrier resisting God’s will collapses in the presence of His power. *Scripture*: (Joshua 6)
17. I declare that miracles follow obedience and validate alignment with God’s instruction. *Scripture*: (John 2: 1–11)
18. I declare that divine help is present, steady, and sufficient even in seasons of trouble. *Scripture*: (Psalm 46)
19. I declare that God’s power is at work beyond what I can measure, imagine, or fully comprehend. *Scripture*: (Ephesians 3: 20)

20. I declare that my life will testify openly to the mighty works of God across generations. *Scripture:* (Psalm 77)

II. DIVINE HEALINGS (21–40)

1. I declare with assurance that my healing rests on Christ's finished work, not on feelings or symptoms. *Scripture:* "By His stripes we are healed." (Isaiah 53: 5)
2. I declare that the Lord Himself stands as my Healer, faithful and unchanging in His covenant. *Scripture:* "I am the LORD who heals you." (Exodus 15: 26)
3. I declare that God's spoken word carries healing power into every area of my life. *Scripture:* "He sent His word and healed them." (Psalm 107: 20)
4. I declare that faith positions me to receive wholeness without fear or hesitation. *Scripture:* "Your faith has made you well." (Mark 5: 34)
5. I declare that Jesus' healing compassion reaches every form of sickness and disease. *Scripture:* "Jesus healed all who were sick." (Matthew 8: 16)
6. I declare that faith-filled prayer releases saving and restoring power. *Scripture:* "The prayer of faith will save the sick." (James 5: 15)
7. I declare that healing virtue flows from Christ into my body without limitation. *Scripture:* "Virtue went out from Him and healed them." (Luke 6: 19)
8. I declare that my days are preserved by God's purpose and power. *Scripture:* "I shall live and not die." (Psalm 118: 17)
9. I declare that the life-giving Spirit actively renews my body from within. *Scripture:* "The Spirit gives life to your mortal bodies." (Romans 8: 11)
10. I declare that Christ fully carried my sicknesses so that I may walk in freedom. *Scripture:* "He bore our sicknesses." (Matthew 8: 17)
11. I declare that sickness has no authority or ruling power over my body. *Scripture:* (Romans 6)
12. I declare that recurring affliction is broken and will not return. *Scripture:* (Nahum 1: 9)
13. I declare that God restores what sickness and time have tried to steal. *Scripture:* (Joel 2: 25)
14. I declare that divine life flows through every system, organ, and function. *Scripture:* (John 10: 10)
15. I declare that medical facts must submit to God's truth and verdict. *Scripture:* (Psalm 118)
16. I declare that human weakness becomes a platform for God's sustaining grace. *Scripture:* (2 Corinthians 12)
17. I declare that healing is enforced by covenant, not chance. *Scripture:* (Exodus 23)
18. I declare that the healing ministry of Christ is active and effective today. *Scripture:* (Matthew 4)
19. I declare that wholeness, not fragility, defines my body. (Matthew 9)

20. I declare that my healing serves a higher purpose: the glory of God.
Scripture: (John 9)

III. DIVINE HEALTH & WHOLENESS (41–60)

1. I declare that God desires my total well-being, prosperity, and health as part of His loving will for my life. *Scripture:* “I wish above all things that you prosper and be in health.” (3 John 2)
2. I declare that my body is not ordinary space but God’s dwelling place, worthy of honor and care. *Scripture:* “My body is the temple of the Holy Spirit.” (1 Corinthians 6: 19)
3. I declare that my life is not cut short but satisfied with fullness and length according to God’s promise. *Scripture:* “The LORD satisfies me with long life.” (Psalm 91: 16)
4. I declare that when strength fades, God renews me inwardly and outwardly.
Scripture: “He renews my strength.” (Isaiah 40: 31)
5. I declare that Christ’s peace governs my inner life, steady and untroubled.
Scripture: “Peace I leave with you.” (John 14: 27)
6. I declare that joy from the Lord strengthens me beyond circumstances and emotions. *Scripture:* “The joy of the LORD is my strength.” (Nehemiah 8: 10)
7. I declare that my rest is protected by God, and my sleep is undisturbed and restorative. *Scripture:* “My sleep shall be sweet.” (Proverbs 3: 24)
8. I declare that God’s healing work reaches every sickness and weakness without exception. *Scripture:* “He heals all my diseases.” (Psalm 103: 3)
9. I declare that my days are multiplied and ordered by divine wisdom.
Scripture: “My days shall be many.” (Proverbs 9: 11)
10. I declare that my body is wonderfully designed by God, not fragile or defective.
Scripture: “I am fearfully and wonderfully made.” (Psalm 139: 14)
11. I declare that wisdom directs my choices and preserves my health over time.
Scripture: (Proverbs 4)
12. I declare that rest in God renews my soul and restores balance to my life.
Scripture: (Matthew 11)
13. I declare that anxiety has no ruling power over my body, mind, or emotions.
Scripture: (Philippians 4)
14. I declare that God supplies strength proportionate to every season of my life.
Scripture: (Deuteronomy 33)
15. I declare that divine order governs my body, bringing harmony and stability.
Scripture: (Genesis 1)
16. I declare that longevity flows from God’s covenant and purpose for my life.
Scripture: (Psalm 102)
17. I declare that peace from God regulates my inner systems and calms my whole being. *Scripture:* (Isaiah 26)
18. I declare that disciplined living sustains my well-being and strengthens my endurance. *Scripture:* (1 Corinthians 9)

19. I declare that God sustains my life daily, carrying me through every demand and responsibility. *Scripture:* (Psalm 55)
20. I declare that I do not fade out or break down but finish strong and whole. *Scripture:* (Ecclesiastes 7)

IV. CAREER BREAKTHROUGHS (61–80)

1. I declare that the Lord firmly establishes the work of my hands, causing my labour to endure and bear lasting results. *Scripture:* “The LORD establishes the work of my hands.” (Psalm 90: 17)
2. I declare that advancement in my life comes by divine appointment, not manipulation or rivalry. *Scripture:* “Promotion comes from the LORD.” (Psalm 75: 6–7)
3. I declare that consistent diligence positions me for leadership and responsibility. *Scripture:* “The hand of the diligent will rule.” (Proverbs 12: 24)
4. I declare that the gifts God has placed in me create space and opportunity before the right people. *Scripture:* “Your gift makes room for you.” (Proverbs 18: 16)
5. I declare that I work with sincerity and excellence, knowing my service ultimately honors the Lord. *Scripture:* “Whatever you do, do it heartily.” (Colossians 3: 23)
6. I declare that the Lord actively teaches me how to profit, progress, and steward increase wisely. *Scripture:* “The LORD teaches me to profit.” (Isaiah 48: 17)
7. I declare that fruitfulness marks my labour even in unfamiliar or challenging environments. *Scripture:* “I will make you fruitful.” (Genesis 41: 52)
8. I declare that my professional path grows clearer, brighter, and more productive with time. *Scripture:* “The path of the just shines brighter.” (Proverbs 4: 18)
9. I declare that the Lord directs my steps, aligning my decisions with His purpose. *Scripture:* “The LORD orders my steps.” (Psalm 37: 23)
10. I declare that consistent meditation on God’s word produces sustainable success. *Scripture:* “I meditate on the word and prosper.” (Joshua 1: 8)
11. I declare that excellence sets my work apart and earns trust and credibility. *Scripture:* (Proverbs 22)
12. I declare that God-orchestrated relationships open doors and advance my career. *Scripture:* (Ruth 2)
13. I declare that divine wisdom guides my choices, especially in complex decisions. *Scripture:* (James 1)
14. I declare that what begins small under God’s hand grows into something significant. *Scripture:* (Zechariah 4)
15. I declare that God’s favor surrounds my work and influences outcomes. *Scripture:* (Psalm 5)
16. I declare that provision follows obedience and alignment with God’s principles. *Scripture:* (Deuteronomy 28)
17. I declare that creativity and skill flow through me by the Spirit of God. *Scripture:* (Exodus 31)

18. I declare that my current assignment fits within God's long-term purpose for my life. *Scripture:* (Jeremiah 29)
19. I declare that steady diligence produces increase, progress, and stability. *Scripture:* (Proverbs 10)
20. I declare that my work reflects God's goodness and brings Him glory. *Scripture:* (Matthew 5)

V. SPIRITUAL VICTORIES (81–100)

1. I declare with settled confidence that in Christ I am not merely surviving but overcoming decisively. *Scripture:* "I am more than a conqueror." (Romans 8: 37)
2. I declare that every weapon formed against me is rendered ineffective and cannot achieve its purpose. *Scripture:* "No weapon formed against me shall prosper." (Isaiah 54: 17)
3. I declare that Christ has entrusted me with authority over every expression of the enemy's power. *Scripture:* "I have authority over all the power of the enemy." (Luke 10: 19)
4. I declare that the greater One dwelling within me outweighs every external pressure or opposition. *Scripture:* "Greater is He who is in me." (1 John 4: 4)
5. I declare that truth dismantles deception and leads me into genuine freedom. *Scripture:* "The truth shall make me free." (John 8: 32)
6. I declare that as I submit to God and stand firm, the devil has no option but to retreat. *Scripture:* "I resist the devil and he flees." (James 4: 7)
7. I declare continual thanksgiving because God consistently grants victory through Christ. *Scripture:* "Thanks be to God who gives us victory." (1 Corinthians 15: 57)
8. I declare that the Lord Himself illuminates my path and secures my deliverance. *Scripture:* "The LORD is my light and salvation." (Psalm 27: 1)
9. I declare that the weapons God provides are spiritually powerful and effective against strongholds. *Scripture:* "The weapons of my warfare are mighty." (2 Corinthians 10: 4)
10. I declare that I remain standing after every challenge, fully clothed in God's strength. *Scripture:* "I stand firm in the Lord." (Ephesians 6: 13)
11. I declare that fear has no authority to dominate my thoughts, choices, or future. *Scripture:* (2 Timothy 1)
12. I declare that God's peace actively guards my mind and inner life. *Scripture:* (Philippians 4)
13. I declare that obedience to God deepens and strengthens my spiritual authority. *Scripture:* (John 14)
14. I declare that faith extinguishes every spiritual assault aimed against me. *Scripture:* (Ephesians 6)
15. I declare that confusion is displaced by divine order and clarity. *Scripture:* (1 Corinthians 14)
16. I declare that perseverance under pressure produces lasting victory. *Scripture:* (James 1)

17. I declare that truth anchors my convictions and keeps me stable in changing times.
Scripture: (Psalm 119)
18. I declare that grace empowers me to stand boldly and consistently.
Scripture: (Hebrews 4)
19. I declare that Christ's triumph over darkness defines my identity and destiny.
Scripture: (Colossians 2)
20. I declare that my daily walk is marked by victory, not defeat.
Scripture: (2 Corinthians 2)

VI. ACCELERATED SPIRITUAL GROWTH & TRANSFORMATION (101–120)

1. I declare that my hunger and thirst for righteousness are met by God, drawing me deeper into His life and ways. *Scripture:* "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness." (Matthew 5: 6)
2. I declare that I continue to grow steadily in grace and in the knowledge of the Lord, not remaining stagnant. *Scripture:* "I grow in grace and knowledge." (2 Peter 3: 18)
3. I declare that my mind is continually renewed, reshaped, and aligned with God's truth. *Scripture:* "I am transformed by the renewing of my mind." (Romans 12: 2)
4. I declare that in Christ my past no longer defines me, for I walk in newness of life. "If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation." (2 Corinthians 5: 17)
5. I declare that Christ lives in me, expressing His life, character, and power through my daily walk. *Scripture:* "Christ lives in me." (Galatians 2: 20)
6. I declare that my life bears fruit that endures beyond seasons and circumstances. *Scripture:* "I bear fruit that remains." (John 15: 16)
7. I declare that my spiritual journey is progressive, moving from one measure of glory to another. *Scripture:* "I am changed from glory to glory." (2 Corinthians 3: 18)
8. I declare that God continually grants me the spirit of wisdom and revelation to know Him better. *Scripture:* "God gives me the spirit of wisdom." (Ephesians 1: 17)
9. I declare that I run my race with faithfulness, endurance, and focus, finishing what God assigned to me. *Scripture:* "I run my race faithfully." (2 Timothy 4: 7)
10. I declare that the God who began His work in me remains committed to completing it fully. *Scripture:*
"He who began a good work will complete it." (Philippians 1: 6)
11. I declare that spiritual maturity increasingly defines my thinking, choices, and conduct. *Scripture:* (Ephesians 4)
12. I declare that discipline strengthens my walk and sharpens my spiritual focus.
Scripture: (1 Corinthians 9)
13. I declare that obedience positions me for accelerated growth and deeper fruitfulness. *Scripture:* (John 15)
14. I declare that spiritual understanding and revelation increase steadily within me.
Scripture: (Colossians 1)
15. I declare that righteousness shapes my desires and directs my pursuits.
Scripture: (Psalm 34)

16. I declare that I walk daily in step with the Spirit, not driven by the flesh.
Scripture: (Galatians 5)
17. I declare that my inner man is renewed day by day, even when outward pressures persist. *Scripture:* (2 Corinthians 4)
18. I declare that my spiritual growth becomes a blessing and light to others.

20. I declare that I finish my journey in faith, pleasing God in all things.
